DUTIES: Provides leadership support for a fifteen-person shop. Assists in prioritizing tasks in order to meet time critical intelligence needs. Ensures intelligence division is in compliance with all DOD, USAF, ANG, and MAJCOM instructions, implements training programs to ensure intelligence personnel are mission ready. Assists in planning, writing, and executing exercise scenarios. Supports combat operations as an intelligence officer. Participates in and oversees deployment of personnel to contingency operations, exercises and conferences. Requires excellent oral and written communications skills. Must be SCI-eligible. Should be fluent in computer skills.
