AREA OF CONSIDERATION: All qualified applicants who are current members of the OHIO AIR NATIONAL GUARD,

Successful applicant will be assigned to compatible military position in an appropriate unit of assignment in the Ohio Air National Guard as shown above. This position is being announced in accordance with published state policy and is a Traditional Guardsman (part-time) employment opportunity.

DUTIES: Provides Critical Care Monitoring and Management of the critically ill and/or injured patients transiting the Aeromedical Evacuation System or patients of the Critical Care Ground Support Expeditionary Medical System.

EDUCATION: Effective 1 October 2000, Registered Nurse applicants must possess a bachelor's degree in Nursing accredited by the National League of Nursing. For current members who are Non-baccalaureate degree Nurses appointed prior to 1 October 2000 are exempt from this requirement. The selected will be required to attend the 4-week Commissioned Officer Training (COT) course (in lieu of the Academy of Military Science) if not previously attended.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Actively employed in a critical care/special care unit or a level 1 trauma center. Must have been assigned a minimum of 1 year in one of these areas. Provide proof from civilian employment. Work at least 180 hours per year in the critical care setting. Provide proof from civilian employer. Have completed Basic Cardiac Life Support and Advanced Cardiac Life Support. Provide proof. Maintain all critical care training via civilian job the entire time you hold this position. Any cost incurred will be at own expense. Provide proof of initial and sustainment training in critical care from civilian employer. Able to attend the 2 week CCAT (Critical Care Air Transport Team Course) at Brooks AFB, TX.

EVALUATION PROCESS: Evaluation will be based on the information provided and meeting a Selection Review Board tentatively scheduled to convene during the 18-19 SEPTEMBER, UTA at Rickenbacker IAP, Columbus, Ohio. AF/ANG core values will be incorporated into the interview process.
